PROJECT DETAILS

In 2024, we are carrying out our work in the following areas:

Villa Eliza neighborhood: in this sector we have the participation of more than 40 boys, girls and young people, carrying out training 3 times a week on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays starting at 6:00 p.m.

El Uribe neighborhood: in this sector we have the participation of more than 45 boys, girls and young people, carrying out training 2 times a week on Wednesdays and Fridays starting at 2:00 p.m.

El Plumón Alto neighborhood: in this sector we have the participation of more than 80 boys, girls and young people, carrying out training twice a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays starting at 2:00 p.m.

Our goal is to provide 165 kids the opportunity of hope.
